3. You will **not be allowed** to take your **mobile phone** into the examination room, so please ensure that on the day of your exam **you leave your mobile phone at home or in a safe place**. If you are found with a mobile phone on your person whilst in the examination it will be taken from you by the Invigilator and returned to you after the exam and it may be looked upon as cheating. Your paper may not be marked! The school will not be responsible for the safe keeping of your mobile phone.
4. You will **not be allowed to wear a watch** in the examination, so please ensure that on the day of your exam **you leave your watch at home or in a safe place**. If you are found to be wearing a watch in the examination room you will be asked to remove it and hand it to the Invigilator. It will be handed back after the examination. The school will not be responsible for the safe keeping of your watch. There will be an analogue clock on display in the examination room so that you can pace your exam.
